How to Grow:

- Plant in sun or partial sun
- Blooms all summer
- Water when dry
- Fertilize once a week
- Remove dead flowers and leaves
- Grows 10-13" tall
- Space 11" apart

12" Annual Gerber Daisy Item# 39874

One look at these beautiful daisies with their bold colors and bright faces, it is easy to see why we love them. Plant your Gerber Daisies in sun or partial sun and water when dry. Fertilize once a week and remove dead flowers to keep your plants looking their best.

How to Grow:

- Plant in sun or partial sun
- Blooms all summer
- Water when dry
- Fertilize once a week
- Remove dead flowers and leaves
- Grows 10-13" tall
- Space 11" apart

12” Annual Sunpatien Item# 39874

Add instant color to your patio or garden. Sunpatiens do best in sun to partial shade and bloom all summer long. They grow excellent in containers, hanging baskets or in the landscape. Water when dry and fertilize monthly. Colors include Red, Hot Pink, Coral, Lavender and Pastel Pink.

How to Grow:

- Plant in partial shade to shade
- Blooms all summer
- Water when dry
- Fertilize monthly
- Grows 12-16” tall
- Space 11” apart

12” Annual Ranunculus Item# 39874

Ranunculus or buttercups are a stunning cool season flower in red, white, yellow, purples and oranges. Their flowers with multiple layers of petals add instant color to your patio or garden. Place these striking flowers on your porch or give them as a gift. Ranunculus makes terrific container plants and also long lasting cut flowers. They do best in full sun and prefer to have well drained soil. They grow excellent in containers, hanging baskets or in the landscape. Water when dry and fertilize biweekly.

How to Grow:

- Plant in full sun to partial sun
- Water when dry, do not let wilt
- Temperature 60°F day time, 50°F night time
- Fertilize biweekly
- Remove bad leaves and blooms
